About the Role: Festival Programming & Artistic Development

Our ambition is to establish long-term collaborations with curators who are eager to develop, refine, and strengthen the artistic profile of Styriarte's festivals and productions.

The initial focus of this freelance role is the creation of innovative programme concepts for the Styriarte Festivals 2027 (*The Fantastic*) and 2028 (*The Singing of the Soul*).
